

Environmental policy

The Environmental Policy of AWSA SA results from conscious care for the natural environment. We strive to act in full harmony with the natural environment, adhering to the sustainable development principle.

Autostrada Wielkopolska SA is a special purpose joint-stock company founded to build and operate the 106 km western section of the A2 Świecko – Konin toll motorway, in accordance with the granted concession. Connecting the Republic of Poland to the West European motorway network, A2 forms a key element of the largest infrastructural project in concession structure and system in Poland.

Our mission is to provide fast and safe road connection between Poland and Western Europe enabling the economic development of local and regional communities. The superior purpose of our Company is to ensure the highest quality of motorway service to our users while respecting the environment and safety and in compliance with sustainable development principles.

The company is committed to:

2. Maintain and improve the environment management methods.

2. Manage the identified threats and opportunities of the Company to ensure the correct operation and continuous improvement of the implemented systems.
3. Monitor the project adverse impact on the natural environment in order to verify the effectiveness of environmental protection devices, identify significant environmental aspects, potential threats and rapid response plans.
4. Monitor the wastewater treatment system and test waters before discharging into the natural environment.
5. Monitor and report greenhouse gas emissions.
6. Conduct monitoring in the field of rational and selective waste management in order to limit the volume of generated waste, focusing on efforts to reuse materials.
7. Cooperate with universities and organizations aiming at environmental protection and environmental education.
8. Cooperate with suppliers and subcontractors caring for the natural environment.
9. Monitor construction works so as to minimize waste and noise generation.
10. Strive to ensure rational use of water and electricity.
11. Adopt a rational approach to ensuring biodiversity through fauna and flora monitoring.
12. Raise the qualifications, awareness and commitment of employees for environmental protection.
13. Make decisions in the Company after prior verification of compliance with the assumptions of the environmental protection policy.
